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Teaching format

Master Class based on the central topic of assigned scientific review

The **goal of this module** is to train students in oral presentations on a scientific topic. Students are divided into pairs and assigned a scientific review. The objective is to give a 35 min lecture about a topic corresponding to the review. Students can present something different from the review, in term of plan, content etc..., as long as the presentation is scientific and focuses on the topic of the review.

Organization

The presentations take place over two one-week sessions, one at the end of December and the other at the beginning of January in the presence of a jury of scientists. The presentations are followed by a 10-15 min question session.

Evaluation

Each member of the jury give a mark taking into account the clarity, the pedagogy, the iconography of the slides, the dynamism and the quality of the answers to the questions.
